## Anxhela Mile Speaks to Pace Law Students About the Publication, Fulfilling the Sustainable Development Goals

In chapter 29, "Indigenous Peoples, the SDGs, and International Environmental Law," Anxhela and co-author Railla Puno discuss the integral role indigenous peoples (IPs) play in sustainable development, protecting biodiversity, and mitigating climate change.
