## **Yankwitt LLP's Compelling Advocacy Convinces Adversary to Drop All Claims Against Restaurant Client**

Yankwitt LLP successfully persuaded its adversary to dismiss voluntarily its indemnification and breach of contract claims against our client, a New York City restaurant. The matter arose after the restaurant's employee fell off of a ledge and sustained injuries, for which he received workers' compensation benefits through the restaurant's insurance carrier. The employee then sued the restaurant's landlord, who in turn brought third-party indemnification and contract claims against our client. Yankwitt LLP articulated a powerful argument as to why the third-party claims were frivolous and failed as a matter of law. In advance of incurring costs for depositions, the opposing party surrendered and agreed to dismiss all claims against our client with prejudice – a victory that saved the restaurant from potential considerable exposure and significant legal fees.
